Many applications can be used to create and open Zip files. The most popular is WinZip ([www.winzip.com](http://www.winzip.com)) with more than 160 million downloads, but others such as BOMArchiveHelper and PicoZip can also be used.

Recent versions of Windows XP and Mac OS X have basic built-in Zip applications, but using a dedicated zipping program will give you more flexibility and control over your Zip archives.

Zip files make it easy to keep related files together and make transporting, emailing, downloading and storing data and software faster and more efficient.

Zip files can be useful in many ways — if you want to email a group of files you can "Zip" them up and then send the individual Zip file.

When the file arrives, the recipient simply "unzips" it and all of the files appear as they were with their original structure.

Other formats for archiving files do exist for different platforms, including "GZip" for Unix and "Sit" files for Macintosh.
